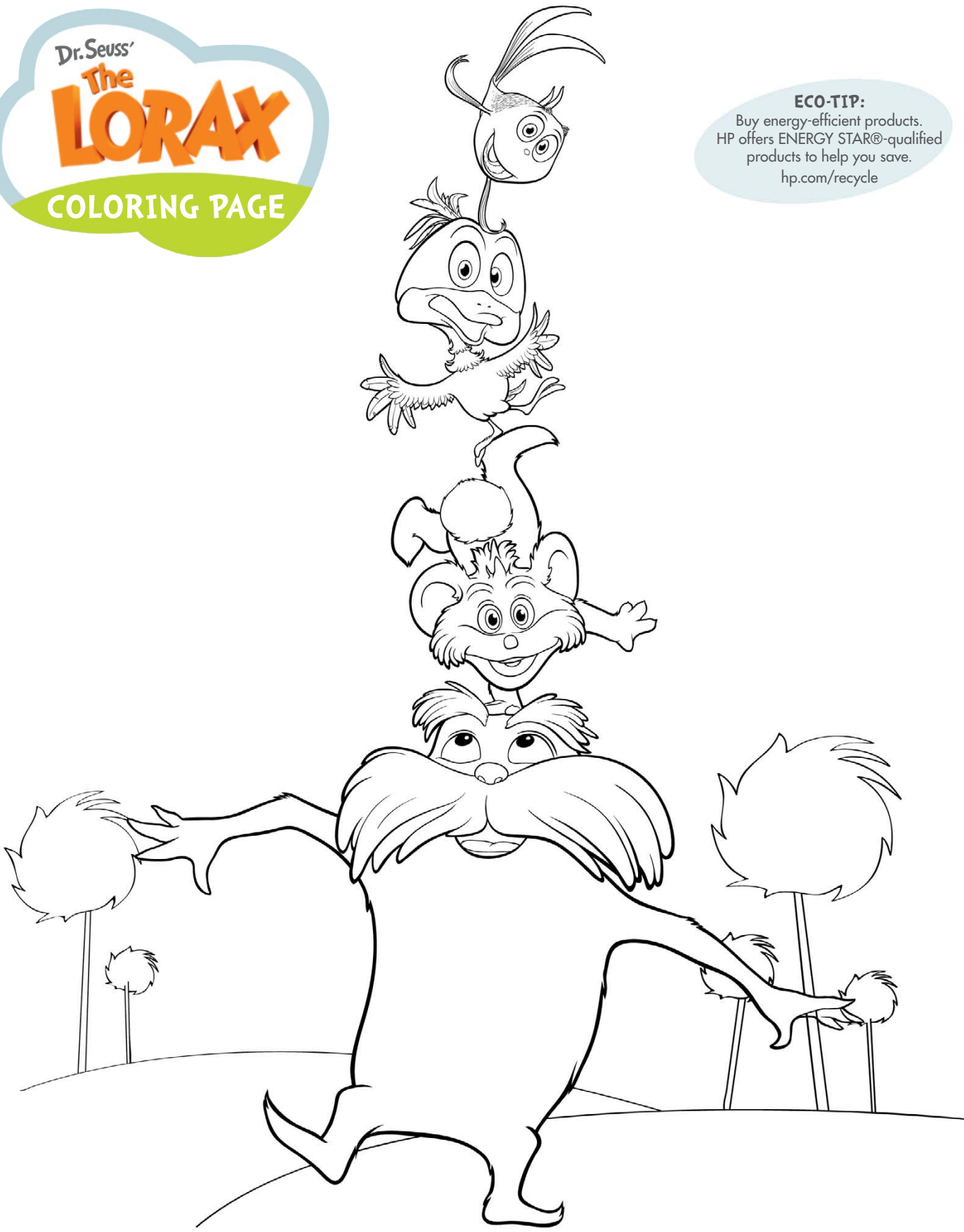

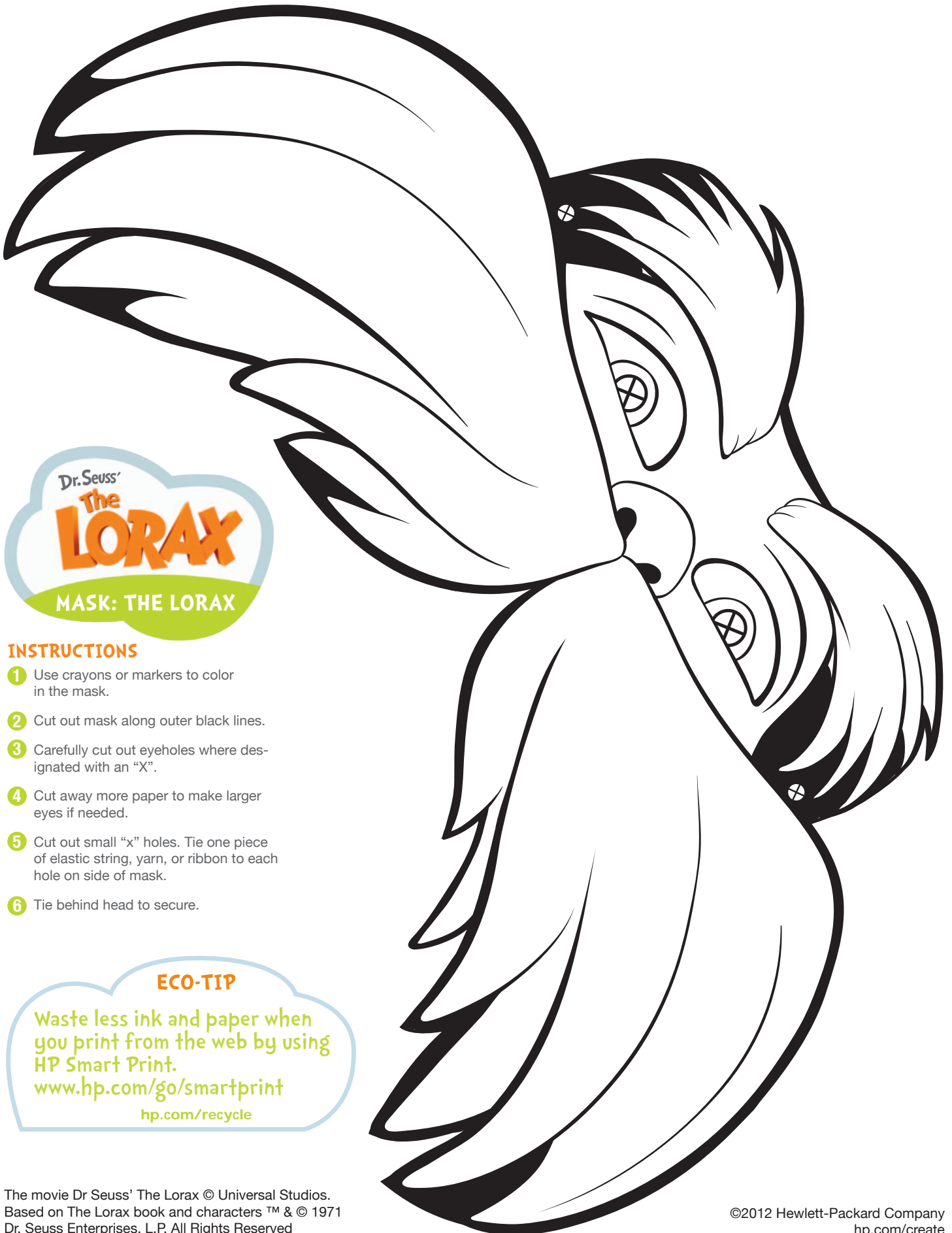

### INSTRUCTIONS

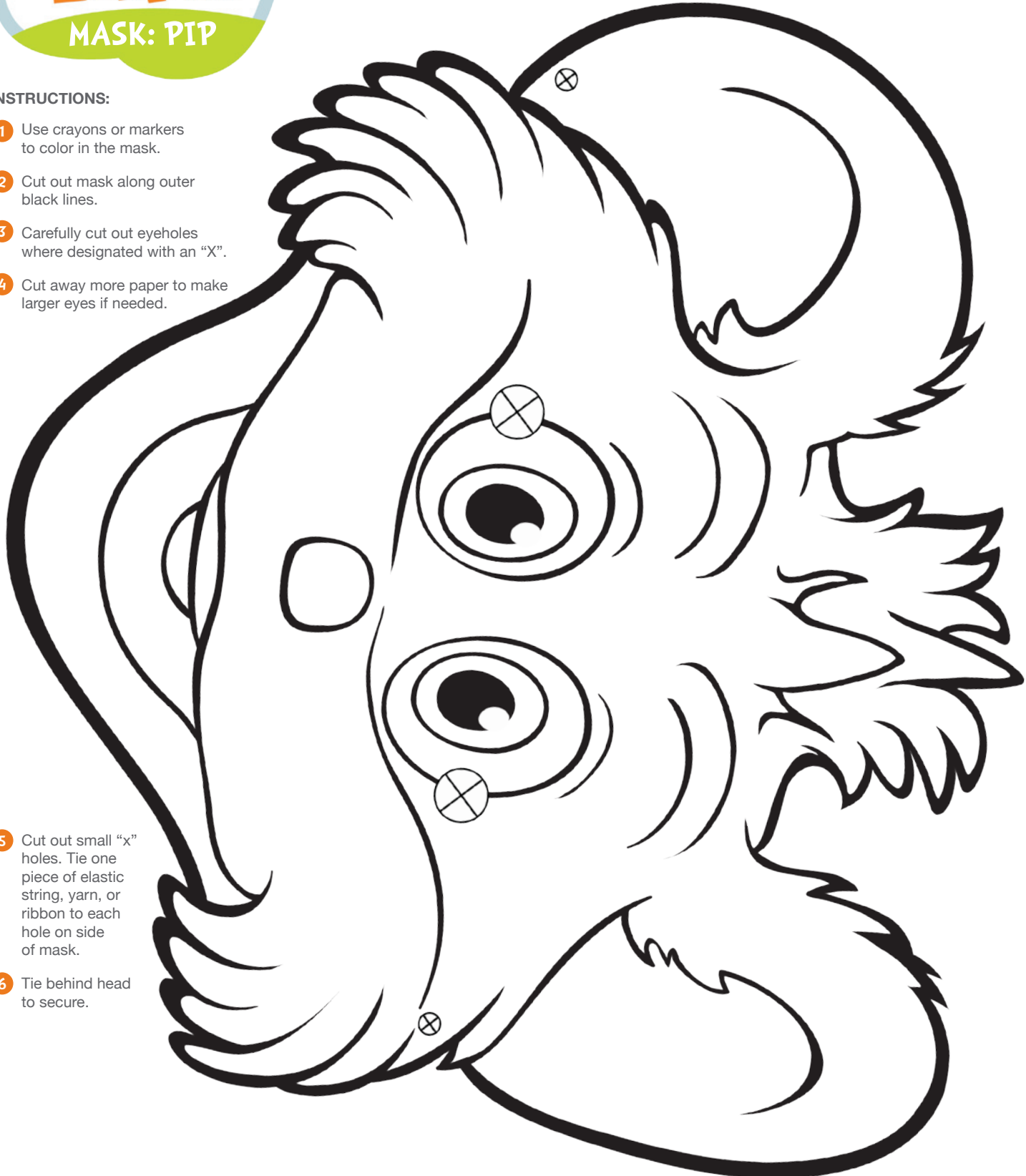

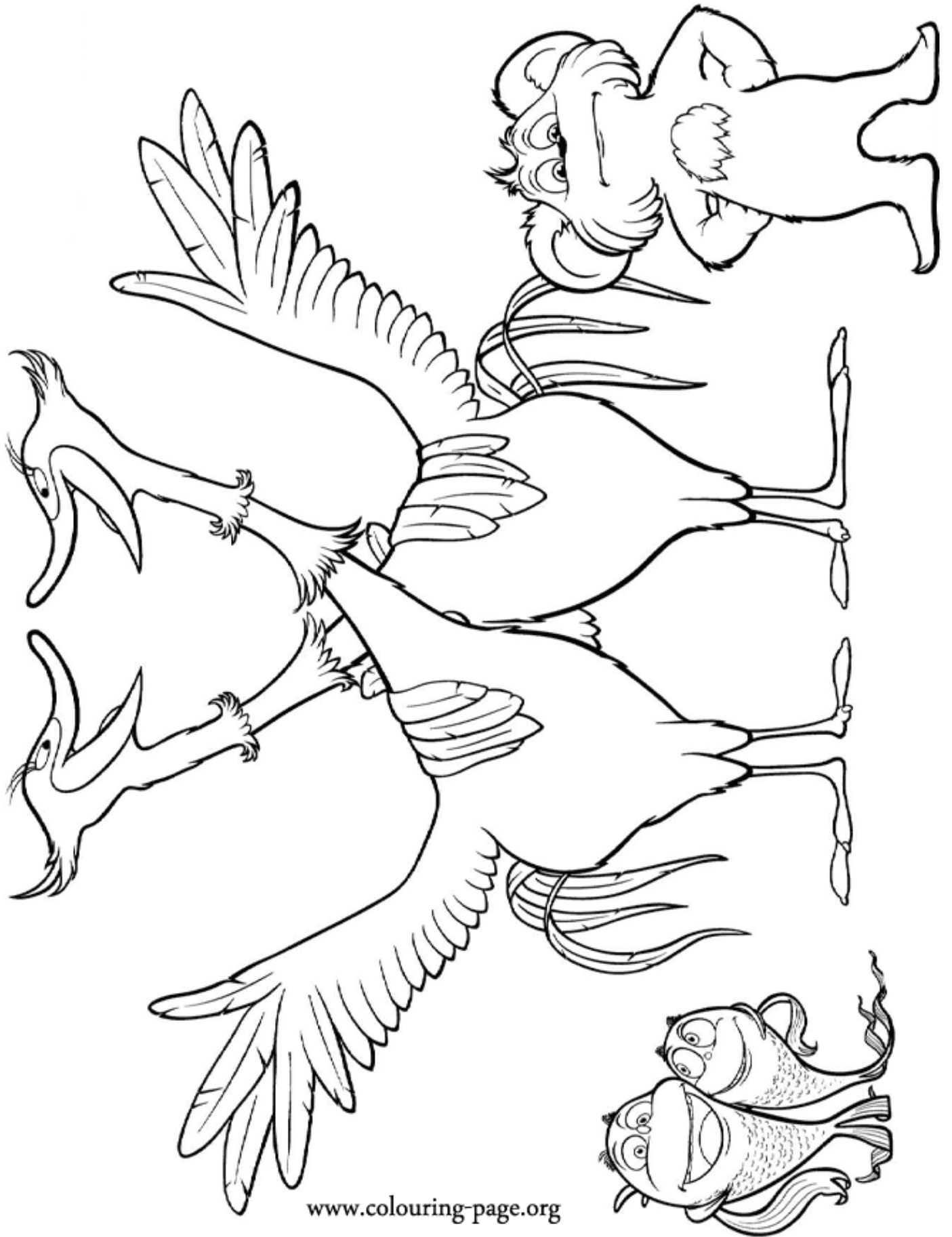
